FUNGICIDAL WASH

Description:

A clear amber liquid. Irritating to eyes and skin. Contains Alkyldimethyl benzyl ammonium chloride 5% w/w. Approved by the Health & Safety Executive for use as a surface biocide. Refer to H & S sheet for full details.

Uses:

Internal:

Beeline Fungicidal Wash is recommended as a prior treatment to walls before the hanging of Wallcoverings.

Fungicidal wash is used to kill and inhibit the growth of mould, fungi and mildew on surfaces including:-

Plaster, Plasterboard, Concrete, Renderings, Paintwork and Wallcoverings (Note: Do not soak Wallcoverings as damage or loss of adhesion may result).

External:

Fungicidal Wash can be used to kill and inhibit the growth of green, black or brown algae and moss on almost all building surfaces including:-

Stone, Concrete, Brick, Renderings, Tiles, Paintwork, Putty, Asphalt and Timber.

External substrates include walls, paths, patios, roofs etc.

Application:

Internal: Apply by brush, sponge or cloth.

External: Apply by brush, watering can or spray (ideal for use with garden sprayer.) Note: Refer to Health & Safety Sheet for precautions.

Internal and external - Areas of heavy algae, fungal or mould growth, several applications will be necessary, likewise with rough masonry surfaces.

On the first application the treatment should be applied and removed by washing with water and a stiff bristled brush. Removal of the growth will therefore be facilitated.

Subsequent applications should be allowed to dry and will remain active for approximately 6 months.

Dilution & Coverage rate:

Dilute **one** part of product with **four** parts of water. Apply 1 Litre of diluted product per 12 - 20 m^2 of surface by brush.

On paths by sprinkler 8 - 11 m² per Litre.

Extensive or well-established mould growth will require a more concentrated dilution: Dilute **one** part of product with **two** parts of water. Apply and allow to stand for 5 minutes before scrubbing into the surface with a stiff yard brush to ensure complete penetration.

Advantages:

- * Does not bleach and will not chemically burn surfaces.
- * Can be spray applied.
- * One product is used for algae, moss, fungi and mould, inside and outside.
- * Will not affect many plants growing on walls. Although contact with plant leaves should be avoided.
- * Can be wiped on with a cloth on smooth outside walls.
- * Use on almost any building surface.
- * When dry will not affect paint applied as a surface coating over the product.
- * When left on the surface Fungicidal Wash has a residual affect of up to 6 months.
- * Health & Safety Executive approved.
- NB: It is advisable to test a small area before extensive use.
